- 1) Title Page
- 2) Abstract, must be one paragraph, and no more than 250 words. A minimum of 150 words are suggested, but not mandatory.
- 3) Index Terms
- 4) Nomenclature (optional)
- 5) Introduction
- 6) Body of Paper
- 7) Conclusion
- 8) Appendix(es)
- 9) Acknowledgment
- 10) References
- 11) Figure and Table Captions
- 12) Photos and Biographies
